Introduction

3. Training may take place via online, Microsoft Teams, Zoom or face-to-face. See individual course details.
4. Generally, courses are restricted to 2 persons / organisation unless informed otherwise via email communications or similar

The courses are described as:

- **Basic Awareness**
- **Intermediate**
- **Advanced**

This is to guide delegates and managers in their course selection.

Basic Awareness – Introductory level and suitable for staff who don't routinely deliver direct work to children at risk or are new to their role.


Intermediate – For Staff working regularly with children and/or the risk is recognised in their work or role. As such they require a more in-depth knowledge of the subject area.

Advanced – this is aimed at staff in a specialist role or where the subject is a consistent feature of their work, knowledge/expertise to be able to work with and advise others. E.g. Designated Safeguarding Leads

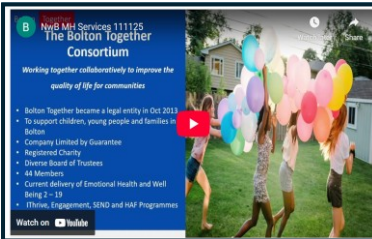

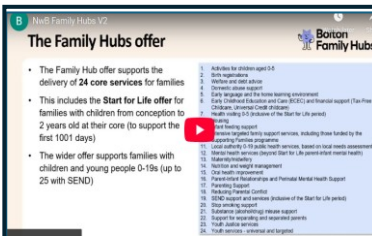
Mental Health Services including CAMHS in Bolton work to support families and children including the work of Bolton Together's offer across 2 – 19 age group.

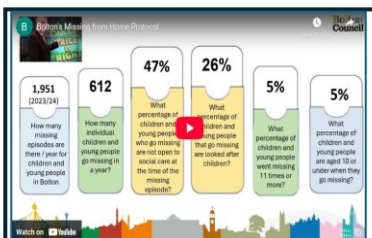

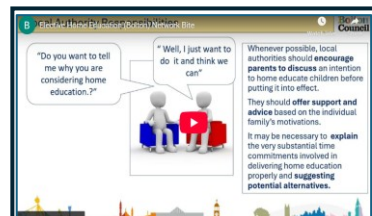

External Training

The training below is provided by credible external sources (E-Learning) and support BSCP's commitment to training. The majority are free to the user

Suicide Awareness [Zero Suicide Alliance](#)

A 30 minute online training package that will take individuals through:

- suicide risk factors
- suicide warning signs
- coached scenarios sharing approaches for how you can talk to someone you're worried about
- videos from people sharing real experiences
- where to find information about available support

At the end of the course, you'll get a training certificate to download

Healthy Minds [Healthy Minds Greater Manchester](#) online course (1 hr)

The Royal Society for Public Health offer online course for anyone living or working in Greater Manchester. At the end of this one-hour course you will better understand:

- the difference between mental health and poor mental health.
- the things we can do to help us cope with our negative thoughts and feelings.

the benefit of talking and sharing our thoughts and feelings with someone we trust

Operation Encompass [Enrol](#)

This free training is available to all schools and education settings including early years' settings and Health Visiting. The training updates staff members' knowledge of domestic abuse, children as victims of domestic abuse, how Operation Encompass works in principle and how staff can support children experiencing domestic abuse. There is also a module about children with other vulnerabilities and children who are Missing from Home or Care. This training will also assist you in developing the skills and knowledge to fully embed Operation Encompass in your setting.

Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) [Virtual College](#)

This free Recognising and Preventing FGM course has been developed for the Home Office by Virtual College. A recent study revealed that 137,000 women in England and Wales are estimated to be living with the consequences of FGM. This course follows a young girl as she encounters the key issues relating to FGM and we see how they affect her throughout her life. The training will help a wide range of professionals to identify and assist girls who are at risk of FGM.

Awareness of Forced Marriage [Virtual College](#)

This online course has been developed with the Forced Marriage Unit of the Foreign Office and aims to raise awareness, challenge perceptions and inform you of the correct actions to take should you suspect someone is at risk.

Safer Recruitment [Virtual College](#) £42 (2 hours)

This Safer Recruitment online training course is designed for those who are responsible for hiring people who work with children. Safer recruitment training online will teach you what is meant by safer recruitment and the practices involved, which legislation underpins safer recruitment, as well as cases where safer recruitment practices could have prevented abuse, how to assess the suitability of candidates.

BSCP Staff Care Scheme

The offer is open to everyone who is part of Working with Children in Bolton.

The Bolton Safeguarding Children Partnership will fund 6 counselling sessions if an individual's circumstances fit the criteria shown. If on conclusion the chosen counsellor assesses needs, we will fund a further 2 sessions.

The counselling is provided for matters relating to staff / professionals who fulfil one of the below criteria.

1. I am a practitioner currently or previously working with a child(ren) where there are Child Protection and or Child Safeguarding concerns / matters and this is adversely affecting me (e.g. work-related stress, trauma, and other mental health concerns).
2. I am a practitioner involved in a LADO process, and this is adversely affecting my well-being. (N.B This may be as the subject of an allegation, witness or referrer).

The offer is confidential and independent from any care scheme you may have in your work place.
